PRAYING GOD'S WORD

TOP TEN NEEDS—HOW TO PRAY SCRIPTURE CONCERNING THEM

SALVATION Romans 10:9--that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved. Romans 10:13--for "Whoever will call upon the name of the Lord will be saved."

"Lord, I confess with my mouth Jesus as Lord, and I believe in my heart that God raised Him from the dead. I am calling upon Your name alone to save me."

DIRECTION James 1:5--But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all men generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

"Lord, I don't know what to do in this situation (name the situation). I don't have a clue. But, I am asking You to show me what to do and how and when to do it. Thank You for answering my prayer and allowing me to keep coming back to You for direction."

FORGIVENESS—GETTING IT FROM GOD I John 1:9--If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

"Lord, I am admitting my sin to You (Name the sin/sins). I take full responsibility. I blame no one but me. Thank You that You are faithful every time to forgive my sins and to cleanse me from what I have done wrong. Help me to never do this again."

FORGIVENESS—GIVING IT TO OTHERS Mark 11:25--"And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone; so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your transgressions.

"Lord, I come to You and I choose by an act of my will, to release (name that person) from my unforgiving grip. I give up my right to hurt (name that person) back. Thank You God that You now have the freedom to forgive me."

FEAR John 14:27--"Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful. Isaiah 43:2--"When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they will not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, Nor will the flame burn you. II Timothy 1:7--For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

"Lord, thank you for giving me Your Peace in the midst of my fear storm. I know I can't find it anywhere else. I refuse to let my heart be troubled and filled with fear by all I see. I believe that when I pass through the waters of trouble, You will be with me. I believe that when I go through the flood of trials, I will not drown. I believe that when I walk through the fire of adversity I will not be burned because of You. I know that being afraid never comes from You."

WORRY Philippians 4:6--Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. I Peter 5:7--Casting all your anxiety upon Him, because He cares for you.

"Lord, I choose not to worry about (Name what you are worried about), because You told me not to. I trust You. I trust Your timing. Instead of worrying, I am going to worship You and ask You to take care of this. I thank You for the answer in advance. Thank You for how You are going to deal with this. I roll all my worries over onto You. I give it to You and I leave it with You."

TEMPTATION I Corinthians 10:13--No temptation [trial, testing] has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted [tried, tested] beyond what you are able, but with the temptation [trial, testing] will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it.

"Lord, Thank You that no temptation can come my way that is new to You. Thank You that You will not allow more temptation into my life than I can—in Your power—say "No" to. Thank You for always making a way of escape—placing an Exit—over every temptation. Help me to look for those ways of escape."

HEALING Jeremiah 17:14--Heal me, O Lord, and I will be healed; Save me and I will be saved, For Thou art my praise. Psalm 103:1-3--Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget none of His benefits; Who pardons all your iniquities; Who heals all your diseases.

"Lord, You alone have the power to heal me of (you fill-in-the-blank). I praise You and thank You for all the benefits You offer. You alone can heal disease. I am asking You to heal me (you may insert someone else's name) completely. I therefore, put my condition (or condition of the one you are praying for) into Your hands. I trust whatever You decide. No matter what, I will look to You."

DELIVERANCE John 8:32--and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:36--"If therefore the Son shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.

"Lord, I accept the truth of Your Word. I agree with You about the mess I am in. It is my own fault. I am now acting upon the truth of Your Word, believing it will set me free from these chains of bondage. Jesus, I believe You alone can and will deliver me."

NEEDS Matthew 6:33--"But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you. Philippians 4:19--And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

"Lord, I seek You and getting totally right with You first. I make You number one in my life. Therefore, I am trusting You to bring everything together to meet my needs. You know my need for (you fill-in-the-blank). I am depending upon what You said concerning meeting my every need because of what Jesus has done. I am enthusiastically looking for Your answer."

The Model Prayer **Matthew 6:9-13**

In the model prayer found in Matthew 6:9-13, Jesus teaches us how to pray. Jesus is not saying, "Pray or repeat only these words verbatim," but, "use this prayer as a model for your own praying." We can safely assume that if we follow this prayer, it will work, it will be answered. This provides a daily game plan for your time with God. The Model Prayer becomes your prayer list, a prayer guide.

"Our Father..."

Matthew 6:9 "Father" implies that God is near, God cares, God is listening, God is loving. It matters to God what you are facing. Let Him know that you believe everything He does in your life is for your good. Tell Him you trust Him with everything. Tell Him you choose to believe Him over your circumstances and feelings. Tell Him that you trust Him with your future.

"Who Art in Heaven..."

Matthew 6:9 He is the Omni-God. He is omnipresent-everywhere at once all the time. He is Omnipotent — all powerful, He can do anything and everything. He is Omniscient — He knows everything about everything even your needs and circumstances. He understands your circumstances.

- God, since you are everywhere, I am asking You to touch...
- God, since You have all power, I am asking You to...
- God, since You know everything, I am asking You to give me wisdom for...

"Hallowed be Thy Name..."

Matthew 6:9 Hallowed means holy. God is to be revered; you are to be in awe of Him. Praise Him according to His names.

- El-Shaddai—God Almighty, the All-Powerful One.--Genesis 17:1-2
- Jehovah-Jireh—Jehovah will provide--Genesis 22:14
- Jehovah-Rapha—Jehovah Heals.--Exodus 15:26
- Jehovah-Nissi—Jehovah is my Banner. It has the idea of God bringing the victory.-- Exodus 17:15
- Jehovah-Tsidkenu—Jehovah my Righteousness. Only God can make you righteous.-- Jeremiah 23:56

God's nature is seen through His names. Incorporate the meanings of His names in prayer:

- "Lord, You are more powerful than..."
- "Lord, I believe You will provide..."
- "Lord, I believe You will heal..."
- "Lord, I am asking You to bring me victory over..."
- "Lord, help me to live right and make right decisions."
- "Lord, help me to have right relationships." Pray for the major relationships in your life.

“Thy Kingdom Come...”

Matthew 6:10 God’s kingdom is God’s rule, God’s ownership, God in control, God’s will. You line up your will with God’s will. You make His priorities your priorities. Prayer is not getting God to do your will but discovering His will in a spirit of “yes.” Make sure your priorities line up with God’s. Live Matthew 6:33 “But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.” God’s order is:

1. Jesus
2. Family (spouse then children if married and have children)
3. Church
4. Job
5. Recreation/play

Trouble occurs when any number takes the place of number 1 and when any greater number takes the place of a lesser number.

“Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven...”

Matthew 6:10 This speaks of submission, surrendering every area of your life to God. It means you have no “Keep Out” signs for God in your life. Today, tell Him...

- “Lord, I give You my eyes, let me see through Jesus eyes.”
- “Lord, I give You my ears, let me hear through Jesus ears.”
- “Lord, I give You my hands, let me grasp what you want and let go of that which you don’t want.”
- “Lord, I give You my feet, I will go where You want me to go & stay away from places of temptation.”
- “Lord, I give You my tongue, speak through me.”
- “Lord, I give You my mind, let me think Your thoughts and confess any sinful thought immediately.”
- “Lord, I give You my emotions, may how I feel be under Your control.”
- “Lord, I give You my will, I will do things Your way.”
- “Lord, I give You my schedule.
- “Lord, I give You my relationships.”

“Give us this day our daily bread.”

Matthew 6:11 You are looking to God to meet all your needs. Trust Him to supply every need. God and God alone is the source of your supply. Daily means you live in dependence upon Him day-by-day. What need today do you need to turn over to Him?

- “Lord, I present to You my need for...”
- “Lord, I’m turning ... over to You.”

“And forgive us our debts...”

Matthew 6:12 Confess your sin to God — anything that has come between you and your fellowship with God.

- “Lord, I confess to You...”
- “Lord, forgive me for...”
- “Lord, please restore my fellowship with You.”

“As we also forgive our debtors...”

Matthew 6:12 God will not tolerate bitterness and unforgiveness in our hearts. Forgiveness is surrendering your right to hurt back someone who has, in some way, hurt you.

- “Lord, I have been bitter over...”
- “Lord, I have held a grudge against...”
- “Lord, I choose to forgive ... for offending or hurting me.”

“And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil.”

Matthew 6:13 Temptation means trial, and evil means the “Evil One,” Satan.

- “Lord, if I can miss the testing of my faith, please let me. But, if not, give me the wisdom and strength to get through it.”
- “Lord, help me to pass this test of my faith.”
- “Lord, show me what You are trying to teach me through this test.”
- “Lord, rush to rescue me because the devil is tempting me to...the devil is tempting me with...”
- “Lord, show me those places and people I need to stay away from where I would easily be tempted.”

Prayer of Jabez

I bring _____ before You, for You alone know how to get through to him. I choose to forgive _____ even though he has hurt me by the way he is living. My only motive for praying is to see _____ brought back to You. I turn him totally over to You for You have ways of getting his attention that I could never accomplish. I believe he can change, but only through Your intervention. Whatever You must do to turn him around I ask You to do it. I pray You would bring confusion to his lifestyle. Let him lose his direction on the path out of Your will. Frustrate his plans. May he find no satisfaction in his lifestyle and find no happiness or peace. Please orchestrate circumstances to bring him to a point of desperation. Bring people into his life that You can use to change him. I pray that You would protect him from anything He hears that gives him the wrong advice or that could influence him to go in a wrong direction. Protect him from anyplace he would go that would cause him to stray from You. I pray that You would protect his eyes from things that would negatively impact him and that You would send Your angels around him to protect him from harm or injury. Protect him from those who would have a negative influence on him. Surround him with people who love You and are committed to doing things Your way. Please help him to guard his heart from wrong feelings toward someone. I pray that he would not fall into financial or ethical traps set by the shrewd and ungodly. Give him discernment to see when something is not from You. May he have a passion to serve You, a hatred for anything that dishonors You, and a fervor for personal purity. I pray that You would give him an overwhelming desire to be a person of character and integrity. Guide every step that he takes and teach him something about You in each step. Acrostic memory tool from the word, **PRAISE** can be used as a prayer format for quiet time in the morning, prayer walking during the day, or in the middle of the night...

Praise
Repentance
Acknowledgment
Intercession
Supplication
Equipping

PRAISE: Begin prayer time with praise. Repeat to God a few of the attributes the Scripture records for him. I sometimes repeat to Him the words to a hymn or worship chorus. Philippians 4:6 says, “*In everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.*” Incorporate *thanksgiving* into every aspect of your prayer time. As you praise Him, *thank Him* for choosing to reveal Himself to you.

- God is Who He says He is.
- God can do what He says He can do.
- I am who God says I am—In Christ, I am blessed with every spiritual blessing, accepted in the beloved Son of God, adopted as a child of the King, chosen before the foundation of the world, redeemed by His blood, forgiven by His grace, loved with an everlasting love.
- I can do ALL things through Christ Who gives me strength.
- God’s Word is alive and active in me.

REPENTANCE: After spending several minutes in praise and worship, enter a time of confession and repentance. Confess sins of the thought life such as wrong motives, negativism, a critical spirit, or even right words with a wrong heart. As you repent, *thank Him* for His faithfulness to forgive your sins.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT: Having praised Him and been purified by Him, submit to God’s authority. Acknowledge His right to rule and reign in your life every day. Then willingly and deliberately submit to His Lordship—one day at a time. Deliberately surrender to His Lordship with your heart, knowing that nothing comes into your life that is not filtered through God’s hands of love. Acknowledge Him as Lord and *thank Him* for being so trustworthy with His authority.

INTERCESSION: Ask God to burden your heart with specific people He wants you to intercede for each day. As you intercede for others, *thank Him* for being your Great High Priest and adding power to your petitions.

SUPPLICATION: Enter into a time of prayer for yourself. God has called each of us to love Him, serve Him, and live holy lives. We can only know Him intimately when we bring Him our innermost thoughts, fears, hurts, gains, losses, and desires. Remember two words—“pray to”—ask Him to give you a heart to love Him more and to fill any empty places in your heart with the safety of His love. In supplication for yourself, *thank Him* for knowing you intimately and desiring that you know Him.

EQUIPPING: Conclude your prayer time by asking Him to equip you in every way for a victorious day. Ask Him to give you eyes that “see” Him and ears sensitized to “hear” Him. Ask Him to give you a heart to respond when He opens a door of opportunity, and to empower you to witness as He leads. As you ask for equipping, *thank Him* for never calling on you to do anything He will not readily equip you to accomplish.

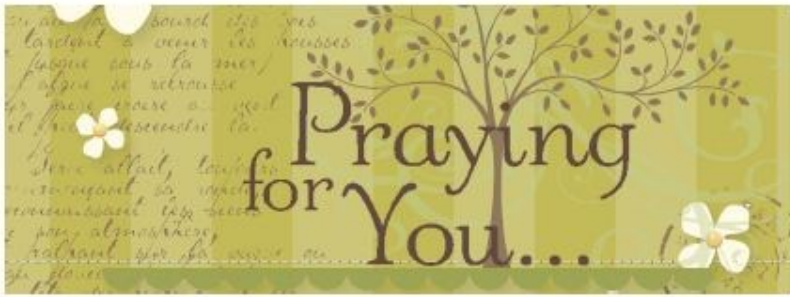

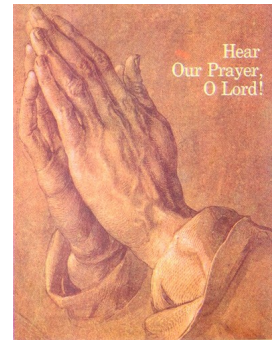
